Dispatches from the Territorial Governor by Sweetwater Jack

OK! As the duly railroad--- Shanghai- uh...APPOINTED... "Coordinator" for the "State of Jefferson Vigilance Committee", it is my pleasure to announce that the Oregon 150th Birthday Celebration in Jacksonville is a definite GO, and our part will take place from 1-4 PM on Saturday, 13 June, 2009.... Current scenarios are "sketchy" but thought is being given to having THREE gangs of "desperados" instead of our usual one gang for the forces of law and order to suppress. Take up arms with the "Evil Jed" gang, the "Purgatory Pistoleros" OR if you normally dress as a lady..... (No! Wimpy, don't even ASK!!) Derringer Donna's Pistolettes?. The thought being that an all-girl outlaw gang would bring a little "class" to what usually turns into an uncouth brawl.... My initial idea is for each "gang" to announce their intention of "taking over the town", and gunfights erupting between the rival gangs, with the "Lawdogs" mopping up (or "reconciling" if the gals win) at the end. In any case, please drop me a short e-mail, letting me know whether or not you'll be attending this shindig, and which gang you want to be a part of.... (No, Wimpy, I haven't changed my mind....) or if you want to be on the winning side with the cops.....

(You can show up earlier to parade about the town in your finery, but our shooting part doesn't start until 1:00.....)

AND THEN..... One week later,,,,, The Yreka "Gold Rush Days" celebration is also a GO! This is going to be on June 20th, the Saturday following the Jacksonville shootout. I have just been in conversation with White Jack Stillwater and he informed me that we will have a FULL CITY BLOCK on 4th Street, plus the Franco-American Hotel and Palace Barbershop on Miner St. He tells me that there is a rumor that the Yreka Western Railroad has been sold, so the usual train robbery is in question, but if it's not running we'll just add more activity in town. More info on scenarios, scripts, props, etc. will be passed on as I get it. The "action" in Yreka usually starts around 10AM and runs through 4 or 5PM.



For those of you who haven't done any of our "shootouts" before, here are the general rules/guidelines. Common Sense....

1. Dress as you would if you were going to be an "extra" or main character actor in a good western movie of the 1870-to 1880s. (Not only "townies" and "lawmen/women" but range cowpokes, too.) In other words like we normally dress for a match or SASS Costume contest.....

2. Don't bring ANY live ammo.... Dummy rounds in gun belts for "show" ? OK,,,,,make sure they're inspected by the safety officers when we do the safety inspection, before any shooting is done. Yes, we DO inspect ALL guns, including derringers, before any shooting is done. If you show up late, please see me or whomever we designate the "official" safety officer for the day, before joining the fracas...

3. I will be loading or buying BLACK POWDER blanks for the events. If you have a strong dislike for shooting black powder in your pistol or shotgun, contact me and I'll show you how to make safe smokeless blanks using florist foam as the "wadding".

4. When the shooting commences, DO NOT point directly at your intended victim (and only shoot at one of US!), but slight to one side or the other, and for pistols no closer than about 15 feet away; shotguns 20-25 feet. (Don't want to set fire to Treacherous Jack's back pocket again....) We don't use rifles for a couple of reasons....we stay in pretty close proximity, muzzle control sometimes becomes a problem (plus, most rifles don't feed the blank ammo very well and shaking and gyrating to make the blank cartridge go into the hole adds to the muzzle control/sweeping problem). And last, if you use the expensive commercial 5-in-1 blanks that DO feed and eject ok. You have empties laying on the ground that retrieving creates the muzzle control thing. And if you DON'T pick them up a spectator sure as hell will, as a souvenir.

So.... Plan and get ready. Let me know who's attending. (Which event or both, so White Jack can inform the caterer in Yreka (Yeah, they're planning to feed us another BBQ dinner!) , and I can plan on how much blank ammo to make and buy....

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT OF MERLIN MARAUDERS

To all Merlin Marauder Cowboys & Cowgirls,

At our February general MM meeting, it was brought to my attention that the new JCSA Range Manager (John) had written instructions not to let cowboy club members practice on steel targets if the Walker Mt. range was being used. This was a concession I never made in my meetings with Lura Johnson and Bob Kurilow. Originally, I conceded to only having our club members shoot on Cowboy Bay #1 and #2 if they were going to practice on steel targets outside our scheduled monthly shoot. This concession was made due to safety concerns if cowboys set up to shoot steel targets on Bays 3,4 & 5.

Today, February 11, 2009, I contacted EVP Lura Johnson and expressed our club's concern over this recent JCSA range policy. After she looked into the matter, she agreed with my understanding of the original agreement which allowed qualified Merlin Marauder cowboys to practice on steel targets on Bay #1 and #2. She further advised that the posted range officer instructions were in error and that she had corrected the instructions. Remember, only SASS certified RO-I and 2 are allowed to set up and supervise practice shooting on steel targets. The JCSA Range Manager has an updated list of all Merlin Marauder ROs. If you are a SASS certified RO and are not on the list, contact me or Molly and we will add you to the list.

In my diplomatic dealings with Lura Johnson, I would like to add that Lura has been fair and attentive to our needs and I am devoted to fostering better relations with the JCSA staff and E-Board. Lura was very helpful in resolving this recent issue and she is to be commended for her actions on our behalf.
