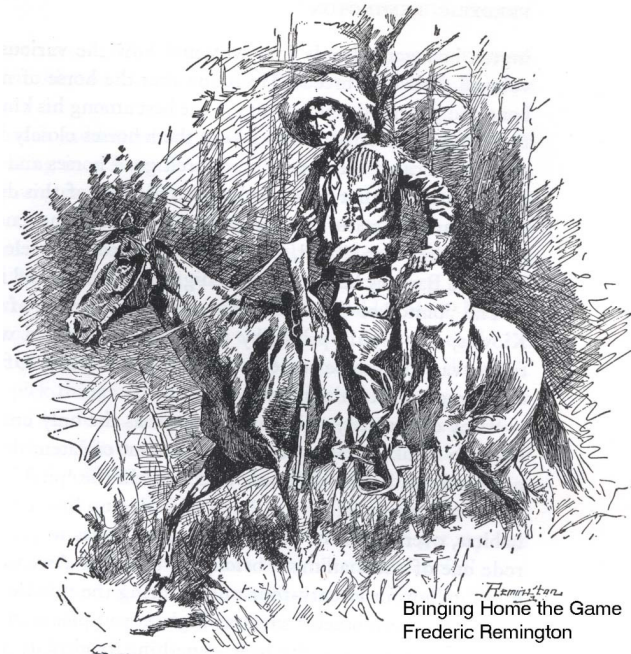

## Dispatches from the Territorial Governor by Sweetwater Jack

A question was brought up on the T/G Wire about the following stage. The main question, as I see it, would be whether or not the stage-writer **would** or **would NOT** be "lynched" by the shooters...

Take a look:

"After the incident at Fort Sackett you deserted and signed on for your first trail drive that lasted three months. You thought that it would never end, but it did and now you're looking for whiskey and some gambling. Wyatt will provide you with both at the Bella Union. He'll let you drink and gamble till you run out of money and we'll let you shoot until you're out of ammo.

10+ Rifle

10+ pistol

4+ Shotgun

### **All Misses May Be Made Up With Reloads On The Clock!**

Pistols loaded five rounds each holstered, Rifle loaded ten rounds held at port arms in doorway, Shotgun open and empty staged on far right table.

Here's the gamble... Before starting you will reach into the bag and draw out a colored poker chip (**Blue 1 in 6 chance**, **Red 1 in 3 chance**, or White 50/50 chance). After drawing your poker chip the TO will tell the spotters your color and wait for you to give the line; "Wyatt you're a cheat and a thief!" (to signify you are ready). TO will then give a "stand by."

ATB: Starting with the rifle

**White** shooters alternate one shot each on two outside, closest and largest white targets for ten rounds then place rifle open and empty on table, move to left window and repeat sequence with pistols. Holster pistols and move to right table and shoot alternating for four shots on two outside, white shotgun targets.

**Red** shooters dump five rounds each on inside medium size red targets then place rifle open and empty on table,

move to left window and repeat sequence with pistols. Holster pistols and move to right table to double tap each red shotgun target.

**Blue** shooters (ain't you lucky!) Ten rounds in far center blue target then place rifle open and empty on table, move to left window and repeat sequence with pistols. Holster pistols and move to right table and shoot four shots far blue shotgun target. Proceed to the unloading table.

Well, of course, that answer lies in the Match Director's Guide, page 4: "**Avoid designing a stage that brings "luck of the draw" into the outcome. Rolling the dice, cutting the cards, spinning the wheel are all excellent means of providing a more interesting scenario, but should not attach a particular benefit for one shooter over another by the outcome. For example, cutting the cards to determine which gun is to be shot first is acceptable while cutting the cards to determine the number of shots to be fired is not.**"

I don't think any of our local monthly club matches have had a stage where "luck of the draw" so to speak, has had any effect on the scoring, but it is a point to keep in mind for all of us that do design stages.

On another subject, When Coyote Calhoun discussed the Wild Bunch written rules that were to be forthcoming, at the Winter Range TG meeting, he indicated that these rules would apply to Regional and above matches. He was aware that state matches and individual clubs can and will deviate from these rules. As a result, many clubs and matches that are hosting Wild Bunch events have relented on the rule that rifles must be .40 caliber or greater, and allowed and are allowing 38/357 rifles in order to expand the number of shooters that might participate. What do you folks think?
