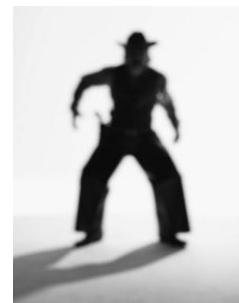
JCSA NEWS : Imnaha Chuck:
