The SHERIFF’S LEGACY

A Story of “Then” and “NOW”

I’VE FOUND IT TO BE TRUE that the folks involved with Cowboy Action and Cowboy Mounted Shooting as well as those with a love of the “Old West” are a surprising bunch of folk, in many ways. The writing talents of some of “our” people continue to delight me. Linn Keller is no exception.

His first novel, in what I’m sure will become more than a “trilogy”, is entitled “The Sheriff’s Legacy”. Firelands County, Colorado has a newly elected Sheriff. Will Keller is a combat-tested Marine. Sheriff Keller is a reserve Lt. Colonel with combat experience in the “sand box” and a person who has a “legacy”. The sheriff’s great-grandfather was also the sheriff of Firelands. The first day on duty often “sets the tone” for just how effective a lawman is going to be in the job, whether in a big city or a rural western community, and sheriff Keller’s first day is a doozy... Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Howdy pards,

Well, there is not much going on within SASS concerning possible upcoming rule changes. Recently, there has been some discussions on the T.G. Wire about eliminating the penalty for leaving an empty case in a long gun. SASS T.G.’s have voted on this issue in the past and it failed. So, there is no reason to expect it will pass this time despite the fact that it is not really unsafe to do so. An empty case in a long gun simply does not pose a threat to anyone.

At this point, in order to change the standing rule, it would have to come by way of a SASS Wild Bunch mandate since there is no SASS Convention and annual T.G. gathering this year. It’s possible SASS could have an email vote among T.G.’s on proposed rule changes, but no procedure to accommodate this has been devised or proffered by SASS.

If there are any RO I’s who would like to become RO II’s, please contact me and I will schedule and set up an RO II class some time this fall. It is recommended that current RO II’s audit the class ---especially if it has been some time since you attended an RO II course. There were a lot of SASS rule changes this past year and a refresher course might be in order. Current RO II’s can attend for free. I can be reached at:
