Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Howdy All,

A recent major change to the SASS RO course materials concerns how to properly handle squibs and firearm malfunctions. The first course of action will now be to ground a malfunctioning firearm on a table or suitable prop. As a last resort, if neither is available, the shooter can hand off the firearm under the direction of the timer/operator. However, the primary method will be to safely ground the firearm. The reasons the SASS RO Comm. is not recommending a "hand off" is because:

- 1. Condition of firearm is often unknown
- 2. Handing off distracts the T/O away from main duty of watching shooter
- 3. Distracts the person who takes the firearm from the T/O (spotter)
- 4. Danger of dropping a loaded firearm while being passed off

Just a reminder.....those planning to attend the next RO II course at JCSA on November 3". after the Merlin Marauder monthly match need to contact me prior to the course date and provide your SASS alias, badge number and true name. The cost is \$25. at the door, but there is no cost for RO II's taking it as a refresher course. It is highly recommended that attendees download a copy of the latest version of the RO II course book from the SASS website.

The Merlin monthly match will start one hour earlier to accommodate this class (Shooters meeting at 8:45 am and shoot at 9:00 am)
