Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

This came up on the T/G Wire recently and I want to share the “problem” and “solution” with you.
The first part (Problem):

I'm sure we all know the P-SDQ-MDQ sequence for shooting out of category, but what do you do as posse marshal or match director when a shooter comes up and says, "Joe Blow shot Classic Cowboy today, and no one caught him using a Winchester '92 for the category during the entire match."

It is not really fair to MDQ the shooter, because they never got the penalty scenario of P-SDQ-MDQ. But it is also not fair to other shooters in the category who complied with the requirements. Do you simply change the shooter to an aged-based or open category post-match? This seems to be the only fair way to deal with this situation. The following is from the ROI Appendix:

"Illegal equipment [penalties](#) are not awarded backwards. If a shooter is found to have illegal equipment, no [penalty](#) will be assessed for the stage(s) already completed.

If a Range Officer elects not to penalize a shooter that has not complied with a rule, the effect is penalizing all other match participants that did comply."

. **The second part (Solution): as evinced by “Chuckaroo” a very knowledgeable and wise T/G:**

Changing a shooter to the category that they really shot is in not a penalty. Odds are the shooter may have not known they were in violation or they were listed in the wrong category to start with. Many scoring systems “remember” a shooter’s category and if he/she changes category for the match, it may not be caught by the person entering the shooter in the program.

You cannot let it slide. But, putting them in a category that matched what they actually shot, corrects the situation, without assessing a penalty after the fact.

If the shooter used a '92 on purpose, knowing it was not allowed, I'd still change his category and then make plans to keep an eye on him/her in the future.

On another subject, I'm so very proud of the way our membership has pitched in to donate clothing, supplies and ammo, as well as friendship and technical support to the 4-H kids (and their families) These 4-H'ers are great kids and they are very appreciative of our support, as evidenced by the letters they've written to the club.
