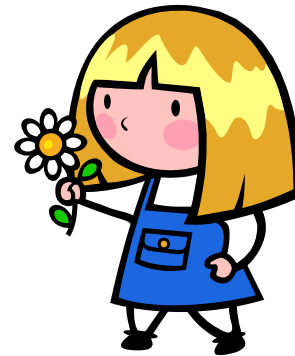

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Here's something from the T/G Wire that I don't think we've ever had come up before, and it kinda' surprised me that a cowboy received a "P" over it: **Marshal Troop, SASS #70448, on 29 Apr 2013 - 04:58, said:**

"Seems lately, I'm running into this more and more. Rules state that only "Gunfighter" and "B Western" category allow for "2 loaded firearms" in hand, pistols of course. But its the "unloaded" firearms that I'm seeing in disagreement. Shooter moving forward with fired/empty rifle or shotgun and drawing pistol, and being given a "P", reason shooting out of category with 2 firearms in hand. My explanation is it only applies to **loaded Revolvers** in hand, (a Gunfighter/B western can move with 2 loaded revolvers as long as they are either not cocked, and the hammers are down on a fired case or empty chamber). Am I missing something? MT"

Response from PaleWolf: Running nto it where? & How often? For one thing, the rules refer specifically to two loaded REVOLVERS (NOT firearms) "in hand". I would suggest that anyone attempting to apply a "P" for "shooting out of category" be requested to cite the rule upon which they are basing that MIS-call.
