Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Looks like the usual Summer doldrums have hit the Rogue Valley..... Heat runnin' in the 90's and 100s have sent us scurrying for shade and crankin' up the A/C. The shooter numbers at most of the local club matches are down both due to the heat and summer vacations, what with the kids being out of school and all. Gaye and I were no exceptions and headed back to Hawaii to take MY kids and grand-daughters to the islands, (*Strictly for educational purposes, of course, to show them Pearl Harbor and instill in them a little feeling for the history of the place....Waikiki Beach and Mai Tais were of little importance in our never-ending quest to educate the young.*)

Trolling the T/G Wire this month has produced just a few things of interest. One item struck my eye, though and it pertains to EXTERNAL FIREARMS MODIFICATIONS: And the following is from our good friend and consummate Territorial Governor, PaleWolf Brunelle: "FWIW - The majority of "new" modifications that are brought to the ROC for review are usually dismissed 'out of hand' as not being listed in the SHB. It is stated numerous times in the "preamble" to the FIREARMS COVENANTS and reiterated at the end that: *"ANY EXTERNAL MODIFICATION TO ANY FIREARM NOT SPECIFICALLY REFERENCED IN THIS HANDBOOK IS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED!"*

Most recently the following were ruled as "illegal" (subject to SDQ if used in a match):

- 1/ Replacement magazine tube that extends beyond the muzzle of the firearm
- 2/ "Counter-boring" the barrel of a rifle to lighten the muzzle. (ie. boring 4" of the bore of a .38 cal rifle out to .44 or .45 cal) Note: This has nothing to do with the "crowning" of the muzzle.
