
Newly elected/ and re-appointed 2014 Club Officers were sworn in by President Daisy at the January general meeting on Tuesday. 14 January.

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

‘Been a few things brought up on the T/G Wire of late that we see over and over again. One of these subjects is that of wearing CROSS-DRAW HOLSTERS... The “good books” of SASS all say:: • **Holsters may not depart from the vertical by more than 30 degrees when worn.. It appears that this rule is being ignored in many places.** I'm wondering if some are measuring the 30 degrees off of the **horizontal** instead of the vertical...it DOES make a huge difference... If it is to be measured off of the vertical as the rule states, then some of the holsters pictured below are being worn at WAY more than the 30 degrees from the vertical. In fact, the gentleman shown in black in the front row at “Greeley’s” is not only WAY out of “spec”, but considering WHERE he’s wearing that thing is in real danger of pulling the wrong “GUN”.. – and I don’t mean the revolver on his right hip!



I don’t think we need to start getting out the protractors and measuring angles or any of that, but remember that the rule says 30 degrees “AS WORN”, and not as laid out on a table. The angles can change quite a bit when some of us with “bellies” strap on our guns.. I won’t even mention the gent on the far right with his shotgun belt half-way up to his armpits....
