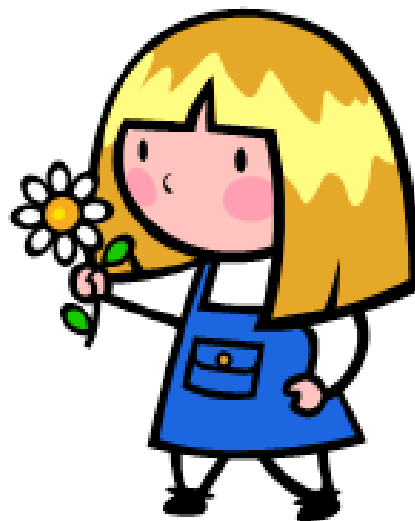
## The Prez Sez:

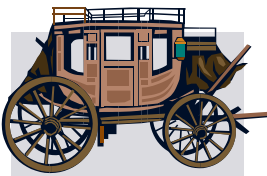

# Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

First of all..... Oregon Senate Bill 1551 to enact legislation to make background checks mandatory for most PRIVATE firearms sales died a quick death with the closure of the Oregon 2014 Legislature Session. (Fortunately the state legislature may only meet for 35 days in “even” years, but meets for SIX MONTHS in “odd” numbered years.) Oregon State Senator Floyd Prozanski and his minions will, no doubt, resurrect this horror NEXT year.

I just read on the SASS Wire that the 2014 SASS Convention (and Territorial Governor Summit) will be held in 2015, instead of 2014. The Menger and Crockett Hotels seem to have “double-booked” with another organization which has priority over SASS. While the SASS Convention will still be held in San Antonio, it has been moved to January 7 to 11, 2015. It will still be at the Menger and Crockett Hotels. Small tidbits of “history”:

1. The BAR at the Menger Hotel is where Teddy Roosevelt recruited his “Rough Riders” for the Spanish-American War.
2. The Menger is supposed to be the “Most Haunted Hotel” in Texas, and some say the entire country. (The Hotel is right where the Alamo’s final battle was fought.. well within the walls of the fort.)
3. Roy Rogers, Dale Evans and TRIGGER used to stay at the Menger when in San Antonio. They stayed in a suite on the SECOND FLOOR and Trigger had a stall (converted from a closet) WITH THEM. (Honest!) Trigger used the stairs.

## Revolvers "in hand" From the T/G Wire:

Page 14 of the Shooters Handbook under Gunfighter, states "The Gunfighter and B Western Categories are the only categories that allow two loaded pistols "in hand" at the same time. This is a two part question. 1. May a **duelist**, while shooting the first revolver, have their hand on the other revolver while it is still holstered? 2. If both revolvers are staged on a table, may the shooter, while shooting the first revolver, have their hand on the second revolver? Is it legal? The following is from the RO I Glossary.

**"Revolver in hand:** When the muzzle of the revolver clears the mouth of the holster, or breaks contact with a prop where it was staged." So,,, : The shooter may have his/her hand on the second revolver as long as it doesn't clear the holster, and, they may touch it on the table as long as it remains **in contact** with the table.

## Is Senior Gunfighter an age based or shooting style category?

Questions come up about “glued-together” categories..... Such as: SENIOR GUNFIGHTER. Although these are not SASS official categories, we need to establish a way to get all sub-categories on the same page.. The discussion at the 2013 T/G Summit resulted in the following:

One issue is some categories permit adjustable sighted guns and others do not. Equipment is the driving force for rules interpretation. In other words a Senior Gunfighter would have to follow Gunfighter rules for shooting style and the equipment used.
