Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Another "what if" from the T/G Wire:

This was posted by a T/G in Texas, who asked for clarification:

"If the first shot of a shooting string is shot out of order and is a miss, and they correct themselves and finish the shooting string correctly, is it a procedural and a miss? We're talking about "obvious" out of order here. Always thought it was, but some have been telling me that since they didn't actually hit the target they just score it as only a miss if the shooter corrects their mistake with the next shot and finishes the string correctly."

You can't go by what you think the shooter was aiming at to give a P. The shot didn't hit anything, so it is just a miss

REMEMBER from p. 24 of the ROI, "A MISS CANNOT CAUSE A PROCEDURAL."

First round was to be on target #1, second round needed to be on target #2 (whatever the target scenario was)

The MISS did not cause a **P**, The **second round hitting target #1 instead of target #2** WOULD cause a Procedural..

Brushy Creek Bill (who originated the thread on the wire) replied:

"OK, let me try to explain better. Target order: 5,4,3,2,1. Shooter shot #1, (**miss**),4,3,2,1(all hits). Definitely not trying to give shooter any extra penalties, but if he shot the first shot at #1 instead of #5 at ten feet apart isn't that kind of obvious on shooters intent? But hey, if it's only a miss then that's great. Brushy"

OK, what y'all are saying does make sense, especially the "must hit" part. Even if the shooter hits "over yonder" it takes all the assumption out of the equation, it's just a miss.



PaleWolf Brunelle, #2495L SASS RO Committee:

The example I use in RO1 class is two targets 30 feet apart. Instructions are to alternate starting on the LEFT target. Shooter fires first shot AT the RIGHT target & MISSES it.Next shot is on the RIGHT target; alternating hits from that point on. Scored as a MISS on the LEFT target with the first shot,,NO "P".

On another subject entirely: Take another look at this month's match results... 16 shooters.... And THIRTY ONE Percent of them in "Cattle Baron" Category! Yeah! Almost One-Third of the match shot by guys over 75! Now look again... How many shooters this month were in a category for shooters UNDER 60?? That's right... just THREE! We've GOT to start RECRUITING YOUNG SHOOTERS.... Or our beloved sport is doomed, even WITHOUT government "help".....
