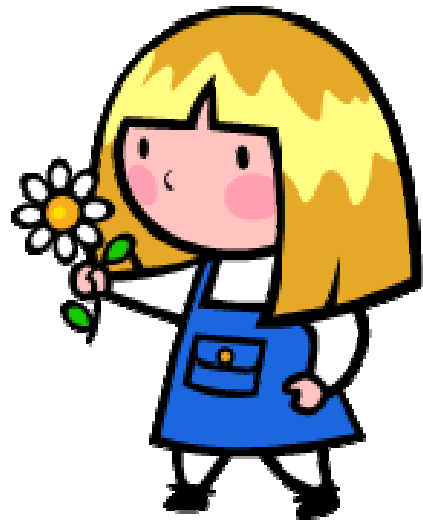
The Prez Sez:

JCSA is now looking to hire a part-time Range Manager. If you are interested, Please contact someone at the JCSA Range Office.

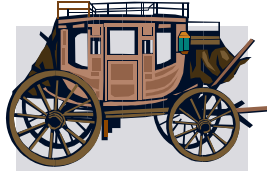

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

I am sure that you are as disappointed as I am that we are not going to have a “Battle of Rogue River” this year. As it turned out there were several factors involved and it simply became impossible to overcome the problems the club faced. Our President, Match Director and Past Pres./Match Administrator presented these problems to the general membership at this month’s meeting and the vote was to cancel the match. If you were at the meeting on May 13 at the Black Bear Restaurant, you know what they were. I will say no more on this subject.....

On to the “Oh YEAH!?! Why CAN’T I section..... From other clubs on the T/G wire:

Situation Number 1. ” I lost a lot of weight, then regained it and now my fancy gunbelts with ammo loops don’t fit, and I can’t afford to replace ‘em. (Again) I need to carry a few extra rounds in case I drop one or jack out a rifle round.. I know I’m not supposed to stick 3 or 4 rifle rounds in a LOOP of my SHOTSHELL belt, but how about I cut down a fired shotshell, push it up into a loop from the bottom, and dump the rifle rounds into the empty SHELL?? The rifle rounds aren’t touchin’ the loop, itself.....the rule states that you cannot carry a rifle or pistol round in a shotgun loop..... but....

As the old Starkist Tuna Commercials used to say.... “Sorry, Charlie!” Here’s the rule: “Ammunition required for reloads in the stage must be carried on the shooter’s person in a bandoleer, cartridge/shotshell belt loop (not a SHOTSHELL LOOP on the belt), pouch, holster or pocket or be safely staged as per the stage instructions. Leather belt slide ammo loops are acceptable however shotgun shell slides may NOT be worn over shotgun shell loops on an ammo belt. Shotgun loops must be in a single row. Rifle or revolver ammo may NOT be carried in a shotshell loop. No ammunition may be carried in the mouth, nose, ears, cleavage or any bodily orifice.”

Situation Number 2. (Again from the T/G wire) What’s the deal with Age-based categories? Our biggest problem is we have boxes to check on our score card that will allow a shooter to check Elder Statesman, Gunfighter, “B” Western. Can you shoot ANY style in Silver Senior and Elder Statesman? We recognize Senior GunFighter Senior Duelist, and if we have enough Senior Double Duelist, but it is my understanding that the rest of the AGE categories are shot any style,

ANSWER: You can shoot any **style** EXCEPT GUNFIGHTER in age based categories. The **ONLY** categories where you can have TWO loaded revolvers clear of leather at the same time are GUNFIGHTER categories and “B” WESTERN, where you can shoot “gunfighter style” . Any “B” Western shooter **MAY** shoot the stage “gunfighter-style” OR “double-duelist” OR with one revolver at a time, “duelist” or “two-handed” (I hate calling two-handed “traditional”, but that’s just ME.... Ride easy pards....
