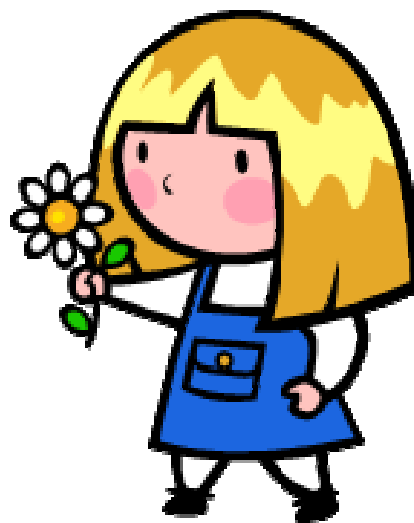

OTHER CLUB MATCHES:

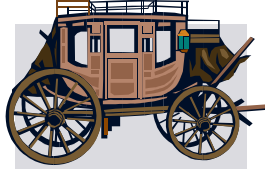

Here's another "What's the call"?

Round count:: 6+ Shot Gun Rounds

Instructions: With SG, engage 4 lollipops, "faller" and "water bottle" in any order. The faller and water bottle may be re-engaged as necessary.

Shooter fires 5 SG, the 4 lollipops go down as does the faller. **Shooter jacks one out**, keeps pumping and clicking. Shooter quits when water bottle accidentally falls and hits ground, not realizing one round was jacked out. So shooter fired 5. rounds

What is the call?

Miss. If stage instructions call for "6+" then at least 6 must be fired, even if they all go down with 1. Same as when a target falls: before being engaged : It must be engaged. (shoot "where it was")

ANOTHER What's the call:

The stage doesn't matter. Monthly match. Pistols are last in the order. Shooter shoots first pistol, Pulls the second pistol and one round does not go off. He cycles around and confirms a round won't go off. He opens the gate, loads one, shoots and holsters. He goes to the UT and they give him a minor safety for having a live round left in the pistol. The hammer was down on the empty he shot last.

Correct call is: no call

Per Pale Wolf: NO CALL...and there is no need to ground the revolver if the hammer is down on the last fired round. There is a short list of MSV's in the RO1 "Penalty Overview"...leaving a live round in a revolver is NOT one of them. If he hadn't replaced it, he would only have a miss for the unfired round.

There is also no need to eject the "dud" if there's an empty chamber in the cylinder to load a replacement.
