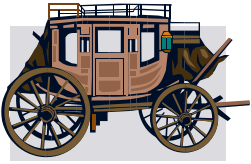

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

The Following was taken from a question on the TG Wire:

You’ve seen it happen. It might have even happened to you. A dropped gun. It’s commonly understood that a match disqualification (MDQ) is given for a loaded gun that is dropped, but I’ve seen confusion over an empty gun that is dropped, particularly if it is off the firing line. It seems simple enough. If it’s dropped on the firing line, it’s a Stage DQ. If it’s dropped off the firing line, it’s a no call.

The confusion seems to come determining where the firing line begins and ends. To define it, let’s take a look at the glossary from the RO1 Course on page 30: “Firing line – From first firearm placed on the loading table until all firearms are confirmed as cleared at the unloading table.”

To get to the brass tacks of it: A dropped gun off the firing line, for example at the gun cart or while standing in line at the loading table is a no call, but the moment a gun is placed on the loading table, the shooter is now on the firing line and remains on the firing line until they have shot, moved to the unloading table and cleared all guns. A dropped gun between those two points will result in at least a SDQ and potentially a MDQ if it is loaded. This means that a shooter while at the unloading table could clear their long guns, clear their first pistol, holster it, clear their second pistol, and drop it while holstering and it would be a no call...because all the guns had been cleared. The same gun dropped prior to all guns being cleared would be a SDQ.

So does this mean that it is impossible to get a SDQ when an unloaded gun is dropped while off the firing line? No. The “freebie” applies to the gun being dropped (during freefall), but if during the process of the gun being picked up while the gun is “in hand,” **sweeping someone is a Stage DQ as it is any other time.** For reference, the following is from page 14, section 2 of RO1 Course: “Muzzle direction is important between, before, and after shooting a stage. A muzzle must not be allowed to “sweep” the other participants between stages, or when moving the firearms from the gun cart to the loading tables.” Guns that are in gun carts (not in hand) or holstered pistols are not considered sweeping.
