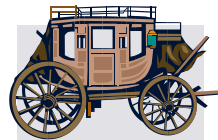

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

SASS Rule Clarification

De-cocking a firearm may not be done to avoid a penalty if cocked at the wrong time, position or location once a round has gone down range. No gun may be de-cocked on the firing line except by pointing it down range and pulling the trigger or while under the direct supervision of a stage officer or timer/operator. Penalty for de-cocking is a stage DQ.

"Under the direct supervision" requires the TO's acknowledgement in an instructive or affirmative manner. In other words, there must be a positive indication to the shooter that the TO is giving his/her approval for the shooters action. There must be positive communication between the shooter and TO.

— (SHB p.21/ RO 1 p.16)

The RO 1 penalty overview specifically refers to "de-cocking a revolver, rifle or hammered shotgun with a live round under the hammer". It does not address de-cocking an empty firearm.

Clarification: If a shooter draws and cocks an empty revolver instead of a loaded one, shooter's best option is to simply pull the trigger while pointing firearm down range. The other option is to obtain approval from the TO to de-cock it. There is no **penalty** for either option.
