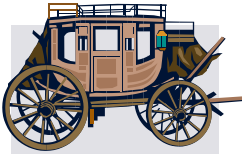

Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Howdy All ... For those who have not yet caught up on a recent 2016 SASS rule change the following was offered by Northwest Chief R.O. Pale Wolf Brunelle.

The following standard should be applied for all style/costume categories when breaking them down by age:

The regulations for the base category will be applied first; Then the age limits.

- AGE BASED
- May use any MAIN MATCH revolver.
- Revolvers may be shot in any SASS legal shooting style except Gunfighter.
- May use any SASS legal MAIN MATCH shotgun and any MAIN MATCH rifle.
- May use any SASS legal ammunition.
- Note: Seniors are competitors 60 years or greater. Senior Duelist is a recognized Duelist category. (See Duelist description for the equipment restrictions and shooting techniques---SHB p. 13)
