## Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Howdy All,

As most of you probably know, SASS will be reallocating the SASS Sanctioned Regional structure for 2018. As a result, all TG's were sent two options mapping plans 'A' and 'B' along with a request that all SASS affiliated clubs vote on their favored option. All TG's were tasked with presenting the two options to their respective club and then submitting their club's vote to SASS.

After I made the SASS Reallocation presentation at the Merlin Marauder club meeting October 11<sup>th</sup>, all attending members voted in favor of option 'A'. This option for the Northwest Region included the following states: Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Alaska

It should be noted that option 'B' included Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Alaska, Montana, Wyoming, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Nebraska. Geographically, this option was simply not practical and many SASS members in Oregon would probably be unable to make the trek to Nebraska or the Dakotas to attend a regional match were it to be held in those states. As directed by the Merlin Marauder mandate, I submitted our club's vote for option 'A' to Misty Moonshine of SASS on October 15th.

Shooting scenario term "in hand" clarified:

Recently, on the R.O. Wire, there was some banter about what exactly the term "in hand" means as a shooter assumes the start position on a stage. According to ROC member PaleWolf, "in hand" includes every start position "up to and including" having a long gun up on a shooter's shoulder aimed at a target or having a pistol out and pointed at a target.

In essence, if the stage scenario calls for the shooter to have a firearm in hand at the start position, the shooter can elect to hold a long gun at low port, high port, from the hip or on the shoulder.

Okay....I know what you'er thinking. The term "in hand" is not defined in any of the SASS rule books. That being said, the term itself is general in nature and is clearly inclusive of the start positions mentioned - as clarified by PaleWolf.

Well, that about wraps it up for me pard. *Happy trails to all.*
