Dispatches From The Territorial Governor

Howdy pards,

Once again, its time for a SASS rule clarification:

Recently, on the SASS RO Instructor Wire an RO was asked if a shooter was allowed to wrap a trigger guard on a pistol with leather since it was allowed on lever action rifles. SASS ROC PaleWolf reminded us that "any external modification to any firearm not specifically referenced in the Shooters Hand Book is expressly prohibited." Therefore, trigger guards on revolvers are NOT allowed to be wrapped with any material.

In addition to rifles, the Shooters Hand Book does allow for the wrapping of shotgun trigger guards with leather or any "natural material." I would encourage all SASS members to review the current SASS Shooters Hand Book which can be found on line at the SASS website — especially, if you have not done so for some time as there have been some rule changes and clarifications for this year.
