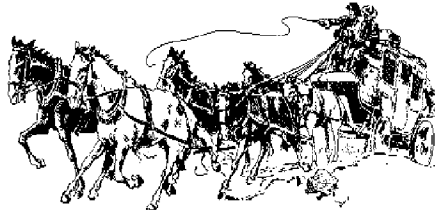

## Dispatches From Our Territorial Governor: Bear Bone Smith

Howdy pards,

Recently there was some controversy on the SASS RO Instructors Wire concerning “end of pistol string.” This resulted in the following rule clarification:

“A pistol string is defined as shots fired from one type of firearm prior to the next firearm engaged.”

In the mentioned case scenario, a shooter was required to shoot 5 pistol shots from one location then move to a second location and shoot 5 more pistol rounds (split pistols). Shooter in this instance fired the first 5 shots at position one and left the pistol on the table prior to moving to the second position. After shooting the second 5 shots, shooter holstered second pistol then retrieved the first pistol and holstered it. The shooter was awarded a procedural penalty. The explanation given was that there were two separate shooting strings because there were two separate locations. The correct call should have been a NO CALL.

The Ruling: “Two revolvers shot back-to-back is a ONE TEN SHOT shooting string. SASS conventions require that the revolver(s) be holstered at the end the shooting string. If two separate locations separate the two 5 shot pistol engagements, the shooter may leave one safely at the first location and then retrieve and holster it immediately after the second 5 shot engagement.”

“A shooter would also have the option to carry the ‘shot dry’ revolver (pointed safely down range) , stage it at location number 2, and then holster both at the end of the string.” *(Per SASS RO Committee member PaleWolf Brunelle )*

### One Quick Added Note:

As most of you know, SASS has decreed that all SASS sponsored matches will now be based on total time as opposed to rank scoring.

Well, that’s all I have for my shootin’ pards this month. Take care and shoot straight..
